Appomattox Co, VA 1845 Tax Lists, 200 acres on the Appomattox River, 20 miles SW of Buckingham CH, tax \$1.40.

Appomattox Co, VA 1850 census, family no. 531, age 82, living alone, real estate value \$1,000, 6 slaves. Jeremiah Sears, family no. 532, is possibly her son.

Nalen** on 23 Jun 1846<sup>1</sup>. She was born about 1798 in Virginia<sup>2</sup>. He married (3) **EMELINE FOSTER** in Jun 1869<sup>1</sup>. He married (4) **ELIZABETH CALDWELL**.

Notes for John Sears II:

Also known as Jack.

ACHS family file states he had nine children, all by his first wife.

All but first wife were his cousins.

"Was a wealthy planter who had 19 slaves."

Appomattox Co, VA 1850 census, family no. 429, occupation farmer, estate value \$3,000, 19 slaves.

- vii. THOMAS ARCHER SEARS<sup>1, 2</sup> was born in 1838 in Virginia<sup>1, 2</sup>. He died on 31 Jul 1861<sup>1</sup>.

3. **JOHN HENRY**<sup>3</sup> **SEARS III** (John<sup>2</sup> II, John<sup>1</sup> I)<sup>1, 2</sup> was born on 09 Oct 1826 in Virginia<sup>1, 2</sup>. He died on 04 Dec 1901<sup>1</sup>. He married **Angeline Amelia Gurley** on 12 Oct 1854<sup>1</sup>. She died on 23 Nov 1900<sup>1</sup>.

Notes for John Henry Sears III:

"led a privileged life as a boy in that he enjoyed good society, good schooling, and a careful and judicious home training."

Before going to medical school, attended Davis Academy and then spent one year at the University of Virginia.

Appomattox Co, VA 1850 census, listed as a Student of Medicine.

Moved from Charleston, South Carolina to Waco, Texas on April 6, 1852 after graduating from medical school.

Civil War: enlisted in the 21st Militia of Virginia, Company 3, Regiment 21 as a private under Major W. H. Seawell at Gloucester Point, Virginia, and was detailed as a hospital steward (see file for additional information).

1893 speech to the Texas Medical Association: "My ambition has been to live and die a high private (citizen). I have tried to live a blameless life, discharging as best I could the duties I owe to my profession and to this association, to suffering humanity, to church, and to state."
